Directory of Grants and Fellowships in the Global Health Sciences

This current volume (NIH Publication 06-3027, February 2006), a comprehensive compilation of international funding opportunities in biomedical and behavioral research. Community of Science

“Community of Science (COS) is the leading global resource for hard-to-find information critical to scientific research and other projects across all disciplines. With COS Funding Opportunities you can search the world’s most comprehensive funding resource, with more than 22,000 records representing nearly 400,000 opportunities.” Each COS Funding Opportunities record includes key information: Title, Abstract, Amount; Sponsor, Contact Information; Deadline, Eligibility Requirements; COS Keyword (a standardized list, applied consistently through all records). COS Funding Opportunities offers a variety of search options. COS Funding Alert is a personalized electronic notification service of funding information. COS Funding Alert subscribers receive a weekly e-mail with a customized list of funding opportunities based on previously specified criteria provided by the individual COS members.

Funding Opportunities Newsletter - s specialized service provided free by GDN to researchers in low and middle income countries, the fortnightly Funding Opportunities Newsletter carries details of relevant funding opportunities from the biggest database of funding information worldwide, the Community of Science.
